- 2. How conscious and aware of God's providence are you in your own life? Is this a truth you value and think about? Is the truth of God's providence helpful in processing the madness and darkness of our days?

- 3. The fact of God's providence doesn't mean we don't act. Who acts by faith in the story of Moses birth?
- 4. Who acts randomly or unknowingly and yet God uses their actions in a huge way?
- 5. Who acts sinfully and yet God uses this to accomplish His saving purposes? Does this give us an excuse to sin?
- 6. **Growth Group as Family:** Stories are powerful! Share your own story of God's providence. In what surprising ways have your seen God work in your life to accomplish His purposes and care for you?
- 7. **Growth Group as Servant Missionary:** The story of Moses teaches us that God uses small actions to accomplish big things. What small action to serve or share the Gospel with others might God be calling your group to together in 2021?

PRAY (use these prompts to pray in response to God's Word)

- Pray for those suffering through this Covid-19 pandemic and pray for it to end soon.
- In light of God's providence, pray for the peace and stability of our nation.
- In light of God's providence, share and pray for one another's needs.
