UNDERSTANDING & APPLYING GOD'S WORD TOGETHER

- 1. Isaiah 1:1-20 sets the tone for the book. Read it together and discuss what you see there. What is God's charge against His covenant people? What is God's call to His covenant people?
- 2. Read Isaiah 36 & 37, part of one of the only narrative passages in the book. What happens here and why is it significant in terms of the overall message of Isaiah's prophecy?
- 3. One of the main elements of Isaiah (and all the prophetic literature) is the reality and certainty of God's judgment. Why is this concept so hard for us 21st Century Americans? Do you think it's equally hard for different peoples in different places?

4.	How does God's sovereignty relate to God's judgment? Do you really believe in God's sovereignty in the world today? How does God's holiness relate to God's judgment?
5.	Read Isaiah 9:1-7 and then Isaiah 53:10-12. Do these passages sound at all like they're describing the same person? What do we learn about our Savior from each?
6.	Read Isaiah 61:1-2 and then Luke 4:17-30. What is the significance of Jesus stopping his reading of Isaiah where he did? What is Jesus claiming in Luke 4 and how do we know, based on the response of the people?
7.	How do the promises of Christ, hundreds of years before His coming, impact your soul?
