Exodus 3 - 4 Sunday, January 17, 2021

- 1. Read Exodus 3-4 again as a group. How did you "come under" God's Word in the text/message this week? What was new, fresh or challenging this week?
- 2. CALL: For Moses, how was God's call interrupting? What did it reveal? How did it disturb and make him uncomfortable?
- 3. CALL: Describe a "burning bush" moment in your life.

- 4. EQUIPPING: Without looking at the outline, but definitely looking at the text, how did God equip Moses for the mission He was giving him?
- 5. EQUIPPING: Share one way God has equipped you for the mission and place/people he's sent you to.
- 6. SENT: Compare the ways that Moses' mission is similar to ours.
- 7. SENT: How often do you see yourself as sent? Why is that?
- 8. Take 5 minutes apiece and share NEXT STEP LISTS with one another. If, by chance, you haven't had time to make your lists, take 15 minutes to make your lists and then share!

PRAY (use these prompts to pray in response to God's Word)

- Pray for those suffering through this Covid-19 pandemic and pray for it to end soon.
- With the story of Moses in hand, praying for your own callings, equipping and sendings.
- Share and pray for one another's needs.
