Connecting & Caring Together

In this 2nd week of Winter Growth Groups, make time to connect with one another. How are you doing this week? Where are you trusting God in your life right now?

Studying God's Word Together

1. The first part of the service highlighted "Sanctity of Human Life Sunday." Is this a Biblical issue or a political issue or both? How is this a Gospel issue? Why must Christians/Disciples care about this issue based on Genesis 1:26-27, Job 12:9-10 and Job 33:4?
2. Sometimes "the sanctity of human life" is reduced to the issue of abortion. The video shown in the service tried to illustrate that it's bigger than that. What other issues are also "sanctity of human life" issues?
3. If we're committed to "the sanctity of human life" as a church and as Christians/Disciples, what sorts of things should we stand for? What things should we stand against? Where in your life are you applying "the sanctity of human life"?

4. In the second half of the service, we talked about how the Bible is organized. It was a very different sort of message! Was it helpful for you? In what ways? Questions?
5. Why is a message like this valuable "preparation" before we embark on our "road trip across the Bible"? Has any one walked you through material like this? Why don't we teach Christians/Disciples this important information?
6. Read Isaiah 66:1-2, what does this passage teach us about God and about His desire for us?
