- 7. Which NEXT STEP will you take this week and why?

PRAY (use these prompts to pray in response to God's Word)

- Pray for those suffering through this Covid-19 pandemic and pray for it to end soon.
- With the story of Moses in hand, praise God in prayer for His mercy.
- Share and pray for one another's needs.
