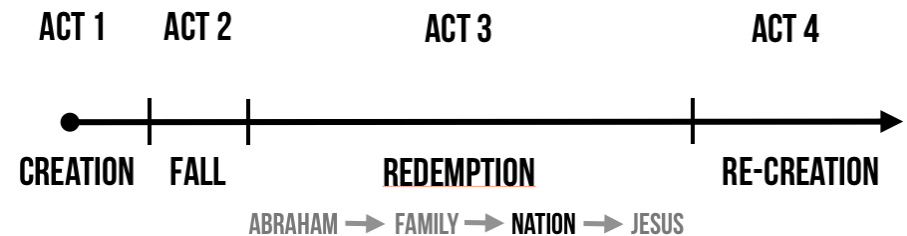

Connecting & Caring Together

In this 5th week of Winter Growth Groups, take time to connect with one another. How are you doing? What's going on in your lives?

Studying God's Word Together

1. If some of your group read through Leviticus this week, please share what that was like for you. Were there any crazy verses in Leviticus that really stood out to you? Was the message helpful in making sense of Leviticus and how it fits in the overall context of God's Gospel Story?
2. Read Galatians 3:19-24. What is this passage saying about the purpose of God's Law? In light of that, how should we read the book of Leviticus differently than an Israelite who had just come through the Exodus?
3. Read Leviticus 20:26 and compare with 1 Peter 1:14-16. If Leviticus is not our instruction manual for holiness, what is?

4. Read Leviticus 16:1-11. What is the first sacrifice for? Read Hebrews 7:23-28. What point is this passage making about Jesus?

5. Leviticus makes clear that sacrifices were to be made for sin on an ongoing basis and every time one sinned. Read Hebrews 10:1-18. What is this passage saying?

6. We often make the point that sacrifices are finished now that Jesus has come, but is that really true, based on Romans 12:1 and Hebrews 13:15-16? What do those passages teach us?
