•	True doesn't mean absolutely LITERAL (Song 1:15)
•	True doesn't mean absolutely PRECISE (Heb 2:6-8; Psa 8:4-6)
•	True doesn't mean absolutely ZERO MYSTERY (Matt 27:5–8; Acts 1:18–19; Gen 5:27)

We continue our Sola Scriptura series with a look at the questions "Is the Bible really God's word?" and "Is the Bible trustworthy?" Here we look at issues related to the inspiration and inerrancy of the Bible.

Biblical Inspiration: God perfectly authored the Bible through imperfect human authors.

Biblical Inerrancy: The Bible is entirely true and trustworthy in all its claims.

1. Is the Bible Truly GOD'S Word?

• The Bible is GOD-BREATHED (2 Tim 3:16)

• The Bible's Author is the HOLY SPIRIT (2 Pet 1:21)

2. If the Bible is TRULY God's Word, then the Bible is TRUE.

• God is HOLY; His Word is HOLY (Psa 18:30)

• God cannot LIE; God speaks the TRUTH (Num 23:19; Psa 119:160)
