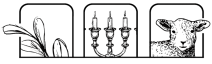
Jesus is Better than Judgment

4. In Hebrews 10:32-34 we noticed that trusting and following Jesus involved 4 realities for these Hebrews? Do you think trusting and following Jesus always involves these 4 realities? Which of the 4 is or would be most challenging for you?

5. Ponder and discuss the Next Step together as it relates to your lives:
