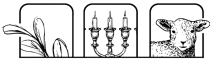
PONDER: Is your faith an addendum to your life or the driver of your life?

CONNECT *(ask these questions to check-in with your group)*

Share about the Next Step for this week as a way of sharing life together.

DISCUSS *(use some of these questions to process God's Word together)*

1. Read Hebrews 11:1-6 together as a group. How did you "come under" God's Word and the message this week? What did you learn? What were the takeaways?
2. How does the world both weirdly mock faith and exalt certain kinds of faith? What kind of faith does the world exalt and how is that different than the kind of faith described in Hebrews 11:1-6?
3. Do you agree or disagree that everyone lives by faith in something? Defend your answer.

4. What does this statement mean? "It is not the STRENGTH of our faith that saves, but the OBJECT of our faith." Why is that a comfort?
5. Which future promises of God are the most inviting to you? Why?
6. Which unseen realities of God are hardest for you to believe and hold on to? Why?
7. What is one area/circumstance in your life where God is calling you to trust Him? What does it practically mean and look like to ACTIVELY trust Him in that place in your life?

PRAY *(use these prompts to pray in response to God's Word)*

- Pray for one another in those areas/circumstances you shared about in question 7 where you need to trust God.
- Share and pray for other needs.
