Connecting Together

- 2. Read 1 Timothy 3:14-16 together. Why does Paul write this letter to Timothy and what do we know about him?

3. In those same verses, how does Paul describe the church? When you think of the church, do you think of it as Paul thinks of it? If not, how do you think of the church? How does what we THINK of the church impact how we EXPERIENCE the church?

- **4.** Churches, communities, organizations and families all rise and fall based on their leadership. Read 1 Timothy 3:6-16 and 6:11-16. What in these verses challenges you to be be a better, more Godly leader in our church, your family and the other organizations you are involved in?
- 5. There's a ton about teaching in 1 Timothy. Back in 3:15, what does Paul tell Timothy the church is to be, in relation to God's truth? What two images does he use to describe the church and what do those pictures mean? In verse 16, what does Paul describe as the center of the church's teaching?
- **6.** Paul describes the church as the "household" or family of God in 3:15. When you think of a healthy family what comes to your mind? Do you think of the church as a family? What would change if you did? How can we improve the health of our church family?

Take some time to discuss why Godly Leadership, Gospel-Centered Teaching, and Family Commitment & Care are important things to look for and strive for in a local church.
