### Connecting & Caring Together

As we near the end of our Winter session of Growth Groups, take time to share your lives with one another . . . joys, struggles happenings, hurts.

### Studying God's Word Together

1. Spend some time together distinguishing between Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers and Deuteronomy. How do they connect and how are they different? What does the word Deuteronomy mean and why is this book called that?
2. The sovereignty of God is all over the Pentateuch (5 books of Moses) and all over the book of Deuteronomy. Read Deut. 7:6-24 for just one example. What are the many ways this text asserts the sovereignty of God?
3. How does the sovereignty of God provide perspective when we look out at the world today? What, if anything, does this overarching Biblical doctrine mean to you personally?

4. Read Deuteronomy 10:12-22 together. What are some of the reasons Moses says the Lord's people should fear, love, obey and serve the Lord?

5. Why do we struggle to trust that God's commands are for our good?

6. Read Deuteronomy 30:11-20. What is the choice laid before the the Lord's people and what's involved in that choice? How is this our choice, too? What are some of the ways we can turn away from the Lord? How does the Lord's Table serve to highlight our choice?
