6. Which of Paul's 4 Gospel priorities is most challenging for you? What is one thing you can do to better align your life with these Gospel priorities?

7. Why must we GUARD the Gospel before and at the same time we PASS the Gospel? What happens if we only GUARD, but never PASS? And what role does SUFFERING play in all this? How have you or how might you practically SUFFER for the Gospel? Are you willing? How can the promised Gospel CROWN help?

Take some time to discuss how your household is doing in Gospel faithfulness, Gospel spreading and Gospel suffering TOGETHER, and how can you do these 3 better together?
