• Since the Bible CENTERS on Jesus . . . with the life, death, resurrection, and ascension of Jesus . . . the Bible is COMPLETE.

The Old Testament FORESHADOWS and PROMISES Jesus. The New Testament REVEALS, EXPLAINS and APPLIES Jesus.

- SCRIPTURE is sufficient and final because the work of the SON is sufficient and final.
- God still speaks TODAY, but only through what He has already spoken in JESUS.

## The Sufficiency of Bible Practically Applied ...

- 1. Because the Bible is sufficient, the Bible is ENOUGH for our faith and life.
- 2. Because the Bible is sufficient, we can hear the VOICE of God and know the WILL of God through the Bible.
- 3. Because the Bible is sufficient, we must reject any attempts to ADD or SUBTRACT from the Bible.
- 4. Because the Bible is sufficient, we ought to be suspicious of any and all REVELATIONS apart from the Bible.
- 5. Because the Bible is sufficient, let us LOVE it, READ it, HEAR it, TRUST it and OBEY it.



Is the Bible Enough for My Faith & Life? Various Scriptures March 18, 2018

Sola Scriptura is the conviction that only the Bible — because it is God's inspired, inerrant Word — is our SUFFICIENT and FINAL authority. But do we really believe the Bible is sufficient? Do we really believe the Bible is enough for our faith and life?

## God SPOKE ...

- Because Jesus is absolutely SUPREME, Jesus is absolutely SUFFICIENT.
- Jesus is God's supreme and sufficient REDEMPTION and REVELATION.
- Because God's work of REDEMPTION is complete in Jesus, so the work of REVELATION is complete in Jesus.
