If you're willing to be bold, share with your group. If not, write it down below and then confess and pray over that this week.

## PRAY (use these prompts to pray in response to God's Word)

 While we didn't discuss this in the message, Pilate makes this statement in verse 5, "Behold the man!" How does this echo Genesis 3:22 and how is Jesus changing what Adam started? Why does that matter today? For further reference read Romans 5:19-21.

- Pray for those who don't yet know Jesus or have faith in him
- Pray for those who will be invited to Easter next Sunday
