He has sent me to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor . . . Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing."

- The ministry of Jesus is the bringing of rest.

- Jesus is raised from the dead to prove that God's promised rest is really found in Him.

Resurrection Rest Matthew 11:28-30 Sunday, April 4, 2021

Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light. Matthew 11:28-30

- The God who rests.

- The loss of rest through sin.
- God enacts a plan to restore rest.
- The promise of rest in a land of rest.
- God gives commands to practice rest.
 - 1 sabbath day every 7 days.
 - ▶ 6 feasts/festivals throughout every year.
 - 1 one sabbath year every 7 years.
 - 1 super sabbath Jubilee year after every 49 years.
- The forsaking of rest.

3. "The Bible is a tapestry of themes woven together to tell one unified story that points to Jesus." Is this the way you think about the Bible? How much have you thought about this theme of REST throughout the Bible?

 Read Luke 4:16-30. What is Jesus saying in this quotation from Isaiah 61. How did the people respond to Jesus? How does this passage help us understand Jesus ministry?

5. In Matthew 11:28-30, where is rest found? How do we get it? Is the finding of rest an event or process? What kind of rest is it? Spend some time exploring together what this rest is actually.

6. What is your NEXT STEP in response to this message?

PRAY (use these prompts to pray in response to God's Word)

- Pray for those suffering through this Covid-19 pandemic and pray for it to end soon.
- As a group, spend some time praying out of Matthew 11, coming to Jesus together for rest and asking Him to teach us to rest.
- Share and pray for one another's needs.
