- 2. What do we mean when we say, "The People gave toward the future." Based on the text, why and in what ways was that future uncertain?
- 3. David highlights at least 10 things about God in his prayer in 1 Chronicles 29:10-19. Which of these characteristics most captivates you? Would you describe David's vision of God as small or big? Would you describe David's vision of the future as small or big? Is there a relationship between our vision of God and our vision of the future?
- 4. 1 Chronicles 29:9 shows us 3 marks of the people's giving. What are they? Why does the text say the people were joyful?
- 5. Describe the peoples response to the opportunity to, by faith, give to the Lord toward the future in 1 Chronicles 29:20-21. In other words, what two things did they do after they pledged and David prayed?


