1. Read all of Hebrews 11, yes, really, it won't take that long. How did you come under God's word in the text and message this week?

2. Have you experienced an area in your life where God led you through victory? Are you willing to share with your group?

3. Have you experienced an area in your life where God led you through suffering? Are you willing to share with your group?

4. There will be times of suffering in our lives where it seems God is distant and that we don't have enough faith to persevere. How does this text encourage you to hold fast to your faith in Christ even if you aren't delivered? What do we have to look forward to? Re-read verses 10, 13-16, 26-27, and 39-40.

5. **FAMILY:** Part of being in the family of God and in a Growth Group is caring for one another whether in good times or bad times. How can your group live like a family to help care for the suffering in your group?

## **PRAY** (use these prompts to pray in response to God's Word)

- For those suffering in your group and in our larger church family, pray that God would deliver them for their good and His glory! Also, pray that God would strengthen their faith to endure even if relief never comes. Pray that we will trust in the promise!
- Thank God for these examples of faith in Hebrews 11, failures and all, and pray that God would increase our faith in Him and in His plan.
- Continue to pray for our brothers and sisters in and around Ukraine to have an enduring faith in Christ and pray for the war to end.
