#### Studying God's Word Together (20 minutes or so)

- 2. Why was David called "a man after God's own heart?" Do you think God viewed him in that light after his big sin in 2 Samuel 11?
- 3. We are living in a day when most of us are cynical and suspicious of any and all leadership. What are the roots of that cynicism and suspicion? Is the answer to toss out the concept of leadership? How does the Bible affirm and show the need for godly leadership?

6. 2 Samuel points us to the Gospel of Christ in two powerful ways. What are they? (Hint: One is found across the narrative and one is found in 2 Samuel 7:12-17)

#### Praying Together (20 minutes or so)

Prayer is an important priority for Growth Groups. Share needs and requests, but also be sure to pray in light of your study in God's Word.

# 4. What are some of the unique external and internal dangers faced by David and all leaders? Read 2 Samuel 11 together as a group. What led David to this broken, sinful place?

5. Read 2 Samuel 12:1-15. What is happening here? What are the consequences for David's sin? Does God forgive David's sin? Are the consequences removed? Why is all this important for us?
