5. Take time as a group to read Hebrews 11:1-12:17. What strikes you in these verses? How do they challenge you? What do they teach us about faith in Jesus?

- 6. Read Hebrews 3:12-19 and Hebrews 10:24-25. What are these two passages emphasizing? How much have you and do you value the fellowship of other Christians? How intentional are you to seek it out? How do you exhort and encourage others "every day"? How can you do this better as a Growth Group?
- 7. Hebrews has more warnings than most books in the New Testament. Because we aren't accustomed to them, many have gotten hung up on the warnings of Hebrews. How should we hear the warnings of Scripture?
