CONNECT (ask these questions to check-in with your group)

What is the pursuit that your heart is pulling you toward this week? Did this pursuit help your race of faith?

DISCUSS (use some of these questions to process God's Word together)

1. Read Hebrews 13:1-6. How did you "come under" God's Word and the message this week? What was most relevant to you this week?

2. Knowing that we are told to run the race of faith with endurance, what did you immediately assume that would entail? Why do you think that our first coaching (after an examination of discipline and the finish line) is a focus on the affections of our heart?

3. Have you ever felt treated like family by a Christian in the church? How and why did that happen?

4. How can we see God's Heart in His emphasis on honoring Marriage Love? What does this tell us about Him?

5. Hebrews 13:5 emphasizes that God will never abandon us. What would this practically look like in our lives if we believed it fully?

PRAY (use these prompts to pray in response to God's Word)

- Pray that the affections of your heart will more closely match the affections of God's heart.
- Ask God to reveal any affections that are sinful so that you can repent of them.
