4. Do you long for eternity? What does that look like in your life? Do you think not-yet-Christians sense a longing for eternity? How do we speak to that, appeal to that, tap that in our relationships with not-yet-Christians?
5. In the message, we highlighted 5 applications of the eternity of God. Which of the 5 was most meaningful for you and why?
6. Read 2 Timothy 1:8-15. How does the eternity of God connect to the Gospel of Jesus?
