- 6. If God is pleased and praised when we commit and recommit ourselves to Him and to one another, why are we so afraid of commitment?
- 7. Though unfamiliar and uncomfortable to us, based on the Biblical evidence, do you think using a written, signed Covenant to express our commitment to the Lord is unbiblical or displeasing to the Lord?
