- 2. What is the joy of Jesus and why does it bring Him joy? How does Hebrews 12:2 show this to be true?
- 3. How can you experience the joy of Jesus?

4. How are you doing with running to others with the joy of Jesus? Is it hard for you to forgive others? Are you willing to be vulnerable and share an example?

5. Growth Group as FAMILY: How are you doing as a family with forgiveness. Are you experiencing this joy of Jesus together? Are there areas where you need to forgive?

6. Growth Group as SERVANT/MISSIONARY: How are you doing with running to others with the joy of Jesus as a Growth Group? How do you talk about others who have wronged you? Would other people find forgiveness in your group?

PRAY (use these prompts to pray in response to God's Word)

- Pray and praise God for the reality of Hebrews 10:11-12 and 12:1-2.
 Thank God that Jesus "for the joy set before Him, endured the cross."
- Pray that God would, by the power of His Holy Spirit, give you the joy of Jesus to forgive others.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit would convict us of sin and that we would repent and ask Him for forgiveness.
- Pray for boldness to share the Gospel with others and for boldness to run to them with the joy of Jesus.
- Pray for the individual needs of your group members.
