*This summer, we are continuing to provide questions in the hope that families and households might use them to interact with the message content of our summer series, "The God You Can Know."*

### Digging into God's Word & the Message Together

1. Have each person briefly summarize the gospel. However, be sure to personalize each account as to what it means specifically for each person. Each account should be a bit different since it deals with each of your unique stories. Use this opportunity to not show off knowledge, but instead express how God has shown grace to each of us.

2. How can you know if you love your sin more than God?

3. God tells Paul that His grace is sufficient for him. Nick highlighted that grace was sufficient for Failures, Value, and Strength. How is God sufficient in those three areas? Which one is easiest to accept for you, and which one is the most difficult to accept?

4. How can you boast in your weaknesses, past and present, in a way that glorifies the Lord?

### Praying Together

Pray with open hands and palms up reflecting an open heart to Jesus...that He might lift us up. Lift up prayers of adoration & praise, as well as confession for any idolatry you are struggling with. Ask God to help you fully trust in His sovereign authority & care... and for His help in submitting to His will.
