This is a Gospel Shadow & Pointer!

- By the Gospel, God has called us to be His DISTINCT people, the CHURCH.
- Because of and for the Gospel, we are called not to ISOLATIONISM or COLONIALISM, but to CAREFUL CULTURAL ENGAGEMENT.

3. A Strong MORAL SENSIBILITY

- Black Panther acknowledges the moral categories of the GOOD, the TRUE and the BEAUTIFUL.
- Black Panther highlights our UNIVERSAL sinfulness and sin STRUGGLE.
- Black Panther illustrates that the consequences of sin are PERSONAL, COMMUNAL and LONG.

This is a Gospel Shadow & Pointer!

- Black Panther is "BORROWING CAPITAL" from a Gospel worldview.
- There is no other "GROUNDING" for these universal truths apart from a Gospel worldview.
- These truths are the "WHY" of the Gospel.
