Ephesians 1:3-14 Sunday, September 13, 2020

CONNECT (ask these questions to check-in with your group)

It's hard to believe that this COVID craziness continues. How are you holding up? What's the best thing and hardest thing about COVID this Fall?

DISCUSS (use some of these questions to process God's word) together)

- 1. Read Ephesians 1:3-14 as you come together as a group. How did you "come under" God's Word in the text and message this week? How did God speak to you or challenge you?
- 2. We're talking about the necessity of ANCHORS this Fall. What happens if we're not hooked into or hanging on to the right anchors? (Play with the climbing metaphor!)
- 3. How is the Gospel anchor given to us in Ephesians 1 THICK? How is it SECURE? How does it make circumstances in the world and in our lives seem small and short?

- 4. What tend to be your functional anchors? In other words, when you're not anchored to the Gospel, where do you tend to look for your identity, your salvation and your security? (Money, success, appearance, influence, family, power, what you know, who you know, achievement, strength, health and more can all be false anchors.)
- 5. **Growth Group as Family:** What is one way you plan to intentionally and strategically anchor to the Gospel this Fall?

PRAY (use these prompts to start your prayer time together)

- Pray for the elimination of Covid-19 and those suffering because of it.
- Pray for one another and your anchoring to the Gospel this Fall.
- Share needs and pray for one another and your families.
