### DISCUSS *(use some of these questions to process God's Word together)*

1. Read Hebrews 1:1-3 together as a group. How did you "come under" God's Word in the text and message this week?
2. What are the "frisbees" that not-yet-Christians around us are hyper-focussed on and obsessed about? Jesus is to be the "frisbee" for Christians, but what sorts of things do you see Christians focussed on and obsessed with instead of Jesus?

3. When you take your eyes off Jesus, where do you tend to look?

4. Of the 7 truths about Jesus in Hebrews 1:1-3, which is most helpful to you as you run your "race of faith" and struggle to "hold fast to your confession" amidst the craziness of the world? Why?

5. Read Hebrews 12:1-3. How do we "look to Jesus?" In other words, what does it practically mean and look like to make Jesus our frisbee?

### PRAY *(use these prompts to pray in response to God's Word)*

- Pray for those struggling through Covid. Pray for the elimination of Covid. Pray for God's mercy to be poured out in the midst of Covid.
- With Hebrews 1:1-3 in hand, take time to praise Jesus for these 7 truths that describe him. Fix your eyes on Him again together.
- Share personal needs and pray for one another.
