1. Read Hebrews 1:3-2:4 together as a group. How did you "come under" God's Word in the text and message this week?

2. Hebrews 1 with its interesting use of the Old Testament, teaches us that all the Scriptures speak of and teach of Jesus. Is this the way you were taught to read the Bible? Is this how you read the Bible today?

3. The Hebrew Christians were captivated and fascinated by angels, a Biblical reality, more than they were captivated by Jesus. What sorts of Biblical or spiritual things are Christians and we captivated by more than Jesus? 4. In Hebrews 2:4, the Author explains how the Gospel has come to us via a 3 step process. Can you identify those three steps?

5. Do you think most not-anymore-Christians reject Jesus all at once or by means of a slow progressive drift?

6. How can we pay closer attention to Jesus and the Gospel we have heard, lest we drift? What do you need to pay less attention to, so that you can pay more attention to Jesus?

PRAY (use these prompts to pray in response to God's Word)

- Pray for those struggling through Covid. Pray for the elimination of Covid. Pray for God's mercy to be poured out in the midst of Covid.
- With Hebrews 2:1-4 in hand, take time to turn your attention to what you've heard, lest you drift away from it.
