2. Why is HOW we share Jesus with people just as important as WHAT we share with people about Jesus? Can you think of some examples to illustrate?
3. What strikes you about the MANNER of John's sharing about Jesus in this text?

4. What do you notice about the CONTENT of John's sharing about Jesus in this text?

5. Read John 20:30-31. What is this and how does it help us understand the Gospel of John? How does this story of the witness of John the baptist connect to these verses and vice versa?

6. How does each of the three "titles" that John calls Jesus (Lamb of God, Holy Spirit baptizer, Son of God) relate to LIFE that we find in Jesus?

PRAY *(use these prompts to pray in response to God's Word)*

- Using John 1:19-34 as a springboard for your prayers, praise Jesus for who He is and the life He gives.
- Pray for those in your circles who don't yet know Jesus or the life He gives. Pray for opportunities to share with them in intriguing, humble, and focused ways.
- Share and pray for one another's needs.
