3. "We see though a glass dimly, but the disciples' glass was dimmer still." Why is this true?

4. In your devotional life, do you tend to relate with God the Father or Jesus the Son? Why do you think that is? Does this passage in John 14 inform how you relate?

5. Why is John 14:6 an EXCLUSIVE statement? Why is the exclusivity of Jesus hard for not-yet-Christians in our culture? Why must the Gospel be EXCLUSIVE? How do we winsomely and caringly explain the exclusivity of Jesus to those who question it? (Might be worth pairing off and role-playing and practicing with one another in your group.)

6. TAKING ACTION: Share which one of 4 Gospel truths from the message you chose as a focus for reflection, journaling and prayer this week. Why did you choose your truth?

PRAY (use these prompts to pray in response to God's Word)

- Use John 14 as a springboard to pray for a deepening knowledge and understanding of the Gospel.
- Coming to the Father through Jesus, share and pray for one another's life needs.
