The readers of Hebrews had become spiritually lazy. They were well instructed but they were not living out their faith. As a result they were not experiencing the benefits of a vital connection to God. It is no wonder that some of them were tempted to revert back to the rituals of Judaism. So the author rebukes their immaturity and tells them to press on beyond the ABCs of Christianity to a vibrant life-transforming faith in Christ. But he warns them that they are at a defining moment in life and in danger of demonstrating a hard heart and a counterfeit faith. Eternity is at stake! But he is confident that their faith is genuine and they will indeed press on with diligent eagerness to imitate faithful followers of Christ.
