GRAPPLING WITH THE WORD TOGETHER (20 - 30 min.)

1. Read John 1:1-18. What words jump out at you in verses 14-18?

5. John tells us in 1:14 that Jesus was "full of grace AND truth." Can you think of episodes in the ministry of Jesus where you see that sweet combination?

6. John tells us in 1:17 that "grace AND truth came through Jesus Christ" which speaks of the saving work of Jesus. So how is the Gospel a sweet combination of grace AND truth?

2. What is grace and what is the truth about why we need it?

FAMILY FOCUS THIS WEEK

A way to apply God's Word in our households together (roommates, housemates, families, couples). Sometime this week, make an opportunity to share/discuss this question. . .

Which way do each of the members of your household tend to lean . . . toward truth or toward grace? What does a household "full of grace AND truth" look like, smell like, feel like?

4. What does "grace without truth" look like, smell like, feel like? What does "truth without grace" look like, smell like, feel like? What does "truth AND grace" look like, smell like, feel like?

PRAYING TOGETHER (20 - 30 min.)

Grace AND truth. Pray that you might grow in the area where you are weakest. Pray that you might be bold in REGIFTING CHRISTMAS with grace AND truth.

3. It's very common for us to lean toward grace or truth and very challenging to be "all grace, all truth, all the time." Which way do you tend to lean? Are you a "grace" guy/gal? Or a "truth" guy/gal?
