- 3. Becoming BEFORE Obeying: ORDER Matters (Eph 4:1)
 - 1. Obeying BEFORE Becoming: It's a TRAP
 - 1. I OBEY a god to BECOME blessed (Eph 2:8-10)
 - 2. I OBEY myself to BECOME blessed (Eph 4:17-24)
 - 2. Becoming BEFORE Obeying: It's a TREASURE.
 - 1. Because I've BECOME blessed IN CHRIST, I now OBEY (Eph 4:1)
 - 2. Since we're UNITED to God, we now LOVE God.
 - 3. Since we're UNITED to One Another, we now LOVE One Another.



Becoming Before Obeying Ephesians 1–3 Sunday, December 29, 2019

We continue our UNITED study of the book of Ephesians with a recap of Ephesians 1–3 and we will notice something striking. Many people approach the Bible as a guide to life. It tells them how to live. However, Paul hasn't given the Ephesians a single command in these first three chapters. Why? Because Christians don't obey to become, but since they've become they obey.
