CONNECTING with One Another (15 -20 min)

Share with one another the value and benefits of meeting together weekly throughout the fall.

EXPLORING God's Word with One Another (20 – 30 min)

- 1. Read Isaiah 9:1-7 together again. What does Isaiah's name mean and how does his name relate with his prophetic message in these verses?
- 2. Why is "salvation" by itself a confrontative and offensive word to contemporary ears? What does the word imply?
- 3. In verses 2-5, how does Isaiah describe the condition of the people of his day (and our day) and how does the Lord's salvation address each condition?

4. The end of verse 4 mentions "the battle of Midian." Read the account in Judges 7. What is the point of this reference in Isaiah 9:6? What is Isaiah saying?

- 5. The coming of the Lord's salvation is counter-intuitive and surprising in more ways than one. Why?
- 6. The first name the Savior will be called is Wonderful Counselor. To what does this title point us? In what ways, does Jesus fulfill and embody this title?
- 7. What is the personal significance of the truth that Jesus is our Wonderful Counselor? Knowing what it means, what does it mean for you?
- 8. Which of the 3 is most applicable for you today?
 - · Seeing your need for wisdom.
 - Seeking Him and finding wisdom (think of a specific issue in your life for which you need wisdom)
 - Submitting to the wisdom of His Word
