CONNECTING with One Another (30 min)

Week #1 of a new quarter is all about connecting and reconnecting, not getting through the message material! So take some time to get to know new folks. Share highlights and lowlights from the holidays and maybe one hope/desire/dream/goal for 2011?

EXPLORING God's Word with One Another (20 - 30 min)

- Read 2 Timothy from the top together to re-acquaint yourself with the flow of the text. What themes jump out at you? What do you remember about the circumstances of sender and recipient? What is happening in 2 Timothy 4:6-8?
- 2. Talk as a group about how we and our surrounding culture sees and deals with death. Why is this? What are some of the underlying roots that give rise to this approach to death? How does this contrast with the Bible treatment of the subject of death?
- 3. We described Paul as "calmly confident" as he faces his own death. What is the evidence of that in 2 Timothy 4:6-8? In other words, how and where does the text show us that?
- 4. Why do we see so few Christians die well. . . . calmly and confidently by faith in Christ? How much of this is rooted in poor preparation

and willful choices and how much is related to a loss of mental capacities?

- Each of the 4 metaphors Paul uses in 4:6-7 to describe how he sees and lives his life of faith in Christ is intended to engage our imagination. What does each stir up in you? Turn them over in discussion together.
- 6. What is the crown of righteousness? Who awards it and why is he qualified to award it? Who is it awarded to?
- 7. "Love his appearing" in 4:8 is a strange, but sweet phrase. What does it mean? How does it color this whole text in a helpful way?
- 8. Which of the 5 challenges poked you the most? What is a step or two you need to take to apply this Word to your life this week and this year?

PRAYING for One Another (15-20 min)

This quarter we want to encourage depth of personal sharing and caring in our Growth Groups, so our goal is to pray for another, not on everyone else in our extended circles. So really focus on sharing and praying for one another in light of this text/message, as well as for any other requests/needs the group has. Let's let God's Word lead us to the throne of grace.
