CONNECTING and Caring for One Another (20 – 30 min)

Remember, the endgame is not to get through all the questions, but to connect over and process God's Word together. This requires sharing what we're thinking about, what we're busy with, what we're struggling through.

EXPLORING God's Word with One Another (20 - 30 min)

- 1. Our current series is called "Doctrine Matters." What is "doctrine"? Why is doctrine considered a bad word or a dry topic or something to be afraid of? When we chuck doctrine from the life of the church, what sort of things do we put into its place?
- 2. What are you learning? How are you being challenged in our "Doctrine Matters" series? Have you had an opportunity to read the new GraceSLO Declaration of Faith? What were your impressions?
- Read Isaiah 46:3-13 and Psalm 104 together. What do these
 passages tell us about God and His involvement in the world? Be
 as specific as you can. Make a list if you must.
- 4. What is God's "providence"? Is that a word/concept that you're familiar with? Why has both the concept and the word itself fallen into disuse?

- 5. Define and distinguish between deism, pantheism, determinism, fate, and open theism. How is the doctrine of providence different than all these?
- 6. How do these 6 truths about God each relate to His providential care and rule of the world?
- 7. Jonathan Edwards said the absolute sovereignty of God was a terror to him initially, but then it became sweet. Where are you at in regards to this Biblical truth? Are you having a hard time believing it? Are you troubled by it? Are you fighting it? Are you surrendered to it?
- 8. What does Romans 8:28 have to do with these Biblical truths concerning God's sovereign providence?

PRAYING for One Another (15-20 min)

We want to encourage depth of personal sharing and caring in our Growth Groups, so our goal is to pray for each other, not for everyone else in our extended circles. So, really focus on sharing and praying for one another in light of this text/message, as well as for any other requests/needs the group has. Let's let God's Word lead us to the throne of grace.

Moving Toward Worship Together

God's sovereignty is the attribute by which He rules His entire creation, and to be sovereign God must be all-knowing, all-powerful, and absolutely free. Were there even one datum of knowledge, however small, un-known to God, His rule would break down at that point. To be Lord over all the creation, He must possess all knowledge. And were God lacking one infinitesimal modicum of power, that lack would end His reign and undo His kingdom; that one stray atom of power would belong to someone else and God would be a limited ruler and hence not sovereign. Furthermore, His sovereignty requires that He be absolutely free, which means simply that He must be free to do whatever He wills to do anywhere at any time to carry out His eternal purpose in every single detail without interference. Were He less than free He must be less than sovereign. —A. W. Tozer, The Knowledge Of The Holy

The Scripture

We believe the Bible is the inspired Word of God, the complete revelation of God's plan of salvation, and the divine and final authority for Christian practice and life.

The Triune God

We believe in one Holy and loving God, infinitely perfect and eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit, who know, love and glorify one another.

Humankind

We believe God created humankind in His own image. Humankind, tempted by Satan, rebelled against God and sinned. As a result, all human beings are alienated from God and corrupted in every aspect of their being, and are lost, blind and dead in sin and in desperate need of the saving grace of God.

The Gospel

We believe Jesus Christ is the Gospel. The Good News of God's sovereign, saving grace is revealed in His incarnation, sinless life, substitutionary death, and victorious bodily resurrection. The Gospel is central to our understanding, interpretation and application of all the Scriptures.

Salvation

We believe salvation is an act of God and is by grace alone, through faith alone, in Jesus Christ alone, for the glory of God alone. God, in His unfathomable grace, justifies sinners who repent of their sins and trust in the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
