#### V. The Son \_\_\_\_\_ US.

Forgiveness and a right relationship with God is by grace alone, through faith alone, in Jesus Christ alone. He is the head of His body, the Church, to be worshipped, adored, loved and obeyed by all.

This doctrine is PERSONAL . . .

- He is OUR SACRIFICE.
- He is OUR SALVATION.
- He is OUR MEDIATOR.
- He is OUR HOPE.
- He is OUR HEAD.

This doctrine is PRACTICAL . . .

- TRUST Him.
- WORSHIP Him.
- ADORE Him.
- LOVE Him.
- OBEY Him.

### I. The \_\_\_\_\_ Son

We believe in Jesus Christ, the eternal, sinless Son of God . . .

#### II. The \_\_\_\_\_ Son

We believe in Jesus Christ, the eternal, sinless Son of God, fully God and fully man. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the virgin Mary.

III. The \_\_\_\_\_ Son

He died on the cross as a sacrifice for our sins,

#### IV. The \_\_\_\_\_ Son

He died on the cross as a sacrifice for our sins, arose bodily from the dead, and ascended into heaven, where He is now our advocate and intercessor. He will one day come again to judge all humanity, reconcile all things to Himself, renew all creation, and consummate His everlasting kingdom.

## CONNECTING and Caring for One Another (20 – 30 min)

Remember, the goal is not to get through all the questions, but to connect over and process God's Word together. This requires sharing what we're thinking about, what we're busy with, what we're struggling through.

#### EXPLORING God's Word with One Another (20 – 30 min)

- Read John 17:1-8 together as a group. What is the setting of this text? What is going on in this text?
- 2. As you read the "Jesus Christ" section of the Declaration of Faith, summarize the movement and flow of the paragraph.
- 3. Where do you see the eternality of the Son in John 17:1-8?
- 4. Where do you see the incarnation of the Son in John 17:1-8?
- 5. Where do you see the sacrifice of the Son in John 17:1-8?
- 6. Where do you see the exaltation of the Son in John 17:1-8?

- 7. Read Philippians 2:5-8 together. How does this text give us another angle on the eternality, the incarnation, the sacrifice and exaltation of the Son? Compare this text with the Declaration of Faith statement?
- 8. Look back and read Ephesians 1:3-14 again. We said last week the Father architects our salvation and the Son accomplishes our salvation. Where is the accomplishing work of the Son mentioned in Ephesians 1?
- 9. How is the doctrine of Jesus Christ the Son of God PERSONAL? How is it PRACTICAL? Or to put it another way... How does this doctrine touch you? How does it speak to you? How does it move you to action?

#### PRAYING for One Another (15-20 min)

We want to encourage depth of personal sharing and caring in our Growth Groups, so our goal is to pray for each other, not for everyone else in our extended circles. #### The Scripture

#### The Triune God

We believe in one Holy and loving God, infinitely perfect and eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit, who know, love and glorify one another.

### Humankind

We believe God created humankind in His own image. Humankind, tempted by Satan, rebelled against God and sinned. As a result, all human beings are alienated from God and corrupted in every aspect of their being, and are lost, blind and dead in sin and in desperate need of the saving grace of God.

### The Gospel

We believe Jesus Christ is the Gospel. The Good News of God's sovereign, saving grace is revealed in His incarnation, sinless life, substitutionary death, and victorious bodily resurrection. The Gospel is central to our understanding, interpretation and application of all the Scriptures.

#### Salvation

We believe salvation is an act of God and is by grace alone, through faith alone, in Jesus Christ alone, for the glory of God alone. God, in His unfathomable grace, justifies sinners who repent of their sins and trust in the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

A believer's membership in the universal Church, the global body of Christ, is to express itself through consistent worship with, service in, commitment and accountability to a local church.

We believe in the visible, personal, glorious return of Jesus Christ, which will bring about the consummation of all things. Those who trust the Gospel of Jesus Christ will enter into joyous, everlasting life with God. Those who do not trust the Gospel will experience everlasting, conscious punishment in hell. 
